2	<b>THE ROMAN WORLD - AUGUSTUS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•To know who Augustus was.</li> <li>•To learn about his character and personality.</li> <li>•To understand what made him such a successful Emperor.</li> </ul>
2	<b>THE ROMAN WORLD – FAMILY LIFE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•To understand what life was like for men, women, children, and slaves in a Roman family.</li> </ul>
1	<b>THE ROMAN WORLD – SLAVERY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•To understand what life was like for slaves in the Roman world.</li> <li>•To understand how well or how badly the Romans treated their slaves.</li> <li>•To learn about Spartacus and his slave revolt.</li> </ul>
1	<b>THE ROMAN WORLD – ROMAN GODS AND GODDESSES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•To learn about the Roman religion.</li> <li>•To know some of the main Roman Gods and Goddesses.</li> </ul>
